2. Sponsor Priorities

Sponsor area	What sponsorship supports	Example outcome
Sponsor a learner	E-learning access, course materials, mentor review and certificate readiness.	Learners can build practical skills and show verified progress.
Sponsor a classroom	Computers, tablets, internet support, projectors, learning materials and setup support.	A school or hub gains practical digital learning capacity.
Sponsor a bootcamp	AI/STEM bootcamp delivery, facilitator support, lesson materials and learner projects.	A cohort receives structured hands-on training.
Sponsor certificates	Certificate preparation, QR verification and learner recognition.	Learners receive trusted evidence of achievement.
Sponsor outreach	Rural/community visits, awareness activities, materials and local coordination.	More learners and families are reached with safe technology education.

3. Sponsorship Levels

WHSF can structure sponsorships to fit the partner's goals, from one-off support to strategic programme collaboration.

Level	Best for	Visibility and reporting
Bronze	Small businesses, individuals and first-time sponsors.	Recognition on WHSF updates and a short impact summary.
Silver	Digital inclusion partners supporting devices, e-learning or classroom access.	Logo recognition where appropriate and activity photos or summary.
Gold	Programme sponsors supporting a full cohort, bootcamp or learning pathway.	Programme-level recognition and a focused impact report.
Strategic	Universities, foundations, technology companies and institutions.	Custom partnership roadmap, joint visibility and long-term measurement.



What sponsors receive

- Clear discussion of sponsor goals and programme fit.
- Impact summary or report based on sponsorship level.
- Recognition where suitable and aligned with WHSF values.
- A responsible partnership process focused on education, inclusion and community benefit.

4. Estimated Impact Guide

The estimates below help sponsors begin a practical conversation. Final budgets depend on country, location, delivery model, equipment type, training duration and partner requirements.

Support	Planning assumption	Estimated impact
\$500	\$50 per learner planning guide.	About 10 learners supported with access, materials or certificate readiness.
10 devices	Each device may support multiple learners over time.	About 30 learners can benefit through classroom or hub rotation.
\$2,500	Digital classroom or bootcamp planning guide.	One classroom or one AI/STEM bootcamp for about 30-40 learners.
\$5,000+	Expanded cohort, devices or outreach package.	Larger learner reach, stronger reporting and deeper programme visibility.

Device donation

WHSF welcomes conversations about safe, usable laptops, desktops, tablets, phones, projectors, routers, robotics kits, sensors, assistive technology and classroom technology tools.



5. Accountability and Next Steps

WHSF aims to build partnerships that are clear, respectful, measurable and aligned with community needs. Sponsorship should create visible benefit for learners while supporting responsible technology, inclusion and human dignity.
